

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, CONCURRING IN THE STATE'S INTENTION TO REMOVE A PORTION OF BUSINESS 287 FROM THE STATE SYSTEM AND TRANSFERRING ITS PROPERTY INTEREST.

WHEREAS, the State of Texas owns and maintains Business Highway 287 from approximately 10 feet south of its intersection of FM Highway 157 to FM Highway 917 , as more particularly described in Exhibit "A" ("Roadway"); and

WHEREAS, the State of Texas has determined that the Roadway is no longer needed for the operation of the state highway system ("State System"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield has requested that the State remove the Roadway from the State System; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield requests that the State remove the Roadway from the State's on-system designation and convey its property interest to the City; and

WHEREAS the City of Mansfield intends to assume the jurisdiction, operation, and maintenance responsibilities of the Roadway upon the real property transfer.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD:

Section 1

That the State's Roadway as shown on the attached Exhibit "A" is no longer needed for use in the operation of the State System.

Section 2

That the City Council of Mansfield, Texas, concurs in the State's plan to remove the Roadway from the State System in accordance with established laws and regulations of the State of Texas.

Section 3

That the City Council of the City of Mansfield, Texas, commits to assume jurisdiction, operation, and maintenance responsibilities for the Roadway.

Section 4

That the City Council of the City of Mansfield, Texas, requests that the State of Texas transfer its property interest at no cost in the subject right of way to the City of Mansfield of said Roadway. It is understood, that if the land that is being transferred ceases to be used for public road purposes, ownership will revert to the State of Texas.

Section 5

That the City of Mansfield, Texas, will begin to assume jurisdiction, operation, and maintenance responsibilities for the Roadway upon an acceptable agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation under the department's turnback program.
