A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE APPLICATION, RECEIVE AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF THE GREAT STATE OF TEXAS AS PART OF THE STATE FISCAL YEAR 2013 GRANT CYCLE FOR PROJECTS THAT PROMOTE A COORDINATED, MULTI-DISCIPLINARY APPROACH TO IMPROVING THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM'S RESPONSE TO VIOLENT CRIMES AGAINST WOMEN.

WHEREAS, The City of Mansfield finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Mansfield (Tarrant/Johnson/Ellis Counties) that projects to assist in developing and strengthening effective law enforcement, prosecution and court strategies to combat family violence, sexual assault, dating violence and stalking crimes against women and to develop and strengthen victim services in such be operated for the state Fiscal Year 2013; and

WHEREAS, The City of Mansfield agrees to provide applicable matching funds for said projects as required by Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division grant application; and

WHEREAS, The City of Mansfield agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City of Mansfield assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full ; and

WHEREAS, The City of Mansfield designates Clayton W. Chandler (City Manager) as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

1. Approves submission of the grant application for projects that promote a coordinated, multi-disciplinary approach to improving the criminal justice system's response to violent crimes against women during the state fiscal year of 2013 to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division of The Great State of Texas.
