**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND  
EXECUTE AN ELECTRIC SUPPLY AGREEMENT WITH  
A RETAIL ELECTRIC PROVIDER OR BROKER FOR  
DELIVERIES OF ELECTRICITY EFFECTIVE JANUARY  
1, 2027**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield's contract for electricity with the TXU expires on December 31, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to execute a contract for electricity for the period beyond the expiration of its current contract; and

**WHEREAS**, wholesale power prices within the deregulated Texas market are largely determined by the NYMEX gas futures prices for natural gas which are currently low and relatively stable, but which change daily; and

**WHEREAS**, daily price changes require retail customers to execute a contract immediately upon receipt of a favorable offer; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 252.022(a)(15) expenditures for electricity are exempt from competitive bidding requirements; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:**

**Section 1.**

The City Manager or his designee are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute full needs electrical service contracts in the wholesale electrical market with retail electric providers or brokers.

**Section 2.**

The City prefers to participate in a fixed price, full requirements electric contract at a price not to exceed 3.8 cents per kWh.
