Dear Mr. Binz:

While processing the request for the 2015 City of Mansfield Hometown Holiday Parade that involves closing part of BU 287P from Dallas Street to Oak Street, it has come to my attention that the portion of BU 287P from the intersection with FM 157 on the north end to the intersection with FM 917 / Heritage Parkway on the south end, is no longer a Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) roadway. This portion of roadway is now owned by the City of Mansfield.

Since the request falls within the limits of the portion of roadway that is no longer a TxDOT roadway, there is no need to seek approval from TxDOT for your event.






