

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH INTERNATIONAL DIOXIDE AN ERCO WORLDWIDE COMPANY FOR THE LEASE OF A CHLORINE DIOXIDE SYSTEM WITH THE PURCHASE OF SODIUM CHLORITE FOR \$0.759 PER POUND; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (UTILITY FUND)

WHEREAS, The City of Mansfield (City) is a home rule municipality operating under and governed by the laws and Constitution of the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, The City requires the supply of chlorine dioxide equipment, services, and bulk tank truckloads of sodium chlorite to be used for drinking water treatment; and,

WHEREAS, The City has publicly advertised and requested competitive bids for the delivery of sodium chlorite to include the rental and maintenance of the generation equipment; and,

WHEREAS, all bids were received, opened, and publicly read aloud on September 22nd at 2:00 PM; and,

WHEREAS, after review of all the bids received, City staff believes that the “lowest and best” bid is that of International Dioxide an ERCO Worldwide company; and,

WHEREAS, funding for this contract is available through the Utility Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The findings and recitations set out in the preamble are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2.

A Contract Lease of a Chlorine Dioxide System with International Dioxide, an ERCO Worldwide company, for the purchase of Sodium Chlorite for \$0.759 per pound delivered which includes the supply and maintenance of the onsite generation equipment.

SECTION 3.

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is passed is open to the public as required by law and the public notice of the time, place, and purpose

of said meeting was given as required.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.
