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A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE APPLICATION, RECEIVE, AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDING FROM FIREHOUSE SUBS PUBLIC SAFETY FOUNDATION GRANT FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE TRAINING EQUIPMENT. THE AMOUNT OF THE AWARD WILL NOT EXCEED \$3,600.00 AND DOES NOT REQUIRE A MATCH

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield and the police department is a unit of local government that meets the criteria established by the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation to apply for and receive grant funds under this program; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield and the police department is seeking an amount not to exceed \$3,600.00 in grant program funding with no match required; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield and the police department agrees to comply with all program rules as set out in the grant program guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield designates Troy Lestina (Chief Financial Officer) as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to ratify and authorize the City Manager and the police department to make application, receive and expend the above mentioned grant allocation, if awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents and make application for obtaining Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation to be used for police training aids utilized in enhancing police emergency vehicle operations safety.

SECTION 2.

The City Manager or designee is authorized to receive and expend the grant funding, if awarded, by the grant program.

SECTION 3.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
