

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-11-02

A RESOLUTION AWARDING BIDS FOR FOOD FOR THE MANSFIELD LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER.

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield, has publicly advertised for the requested competitive bids for food for the Mansfield Law Enforcement Center; and

WHEREAS, all bids were received, opened, and publicly read on September 16th, 2009 at 3:00 pm at Mansfield City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the expenditure for food was budgeted for and will be taken from the General Operating Funds of the Mansfield Law Enforcement Center; and

WHEREAS, after review and consideration of all bids received, it is the best recommendation of the administration and determination of Council that the "lowest and best bids" are: Ben E. Keith for \$36,904.46; U.S. Food Service in the amount for \$53,035.58; Byrnes Brothers for \$13,881.80; and Performance Food Group in the amount for \$ 38,500.66

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to enter into agreement with Ben E. Keith in the amount currently projected at Thirty six thousand nine hundred four dollars and forty six cents (\$36,904.46); U.S. Food Service in the amount currently projected at Fifty three thousand thirty five dollars and fifty eight cents (\$53,035.58) ; Byrnes Brothers in the amount currently projected at Thirteen thousand eight hundred eighty one dollars and eighty cents (\$13,881.80); and Performance Food Group in the amount currently projected at Thirty eight thousand five hundred dollars and sixty-six cents (\$38,500.66) provided herein.

SECTION 2.

If at any time a vendor is unable to honor the bid price, written notification is required. The item will be reviewed and the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to award item to the next lowest bidder if necessary.

SECTION 3.

The City Manager is hereby authorized to approve any change order up to 25% of the contract price as authorized by the Texas Local Government Code.
