A RESOLUTION TO CONSIDER EXECUTING A CONSULTANT AGREEMENT WITH TRC ARCHITECTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$97,700 FOR DESIGN DEVELOPMENT, CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS AND CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES FOR THE PARKS ADMINISTRATION BUILDING

WHEREAS, the proposed re-development of the City's four acres on Smith Street will mean new office space will be required to house the Parks and Recreation and CVB staff; and

WHEREAS, City staff have developed conceptual plans to build a new administration building on existing parkland at the southern end of the Elmer W. Oliver Nature Park; and

WHEREAS, the Mansfield Park Facilities Development Corporation (MPFDC) allocated funds for design of a new Parks Administration Building in the FY2016-2017 budget; and

WHEREAS, the MPFDC voted 6-0 to approve the consultant agreement at their May 18, 2017 board meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS:

Section 1.

That the City Council approves executing a consultant agreement with TRC Architects for design development, construction documents and construction administration services for the Parks Administration Building in the amount of Ninety-Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$97,700).
