A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH TEAGUE NALL AND PERKINS, INC. FOR THE DESIGN OF CHAPEL HILL DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$60,360; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE (DRAINAGE UTILITY FUND)

WHEREAS, The City of Mansfield (City) is a home rule municipality operating under and governed by the laws and Constitution of the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, reports of flooding from the June 2022 rain event were received from several homes in the Chapel Hill Dr. area; and,

WHEREAS, in September 2022, the City engaged Teague Nall and Perkins, Inc. to analyze the existing system and propose drainage improvements in the Chapel Hill Dr area to prevent or reduce future flooding; and,

WHEREAS, City staff and the consultant have concurred on a selected alternative to resolve the flooding issues in the area; and,

WHEREAS, City staff has reviewed and considered a proposal from Teague Nall and Perkins, Inc. for engineering design services for drainage improvements in the Chapel Hill Dr. area and recommends approval of a professional services contract for said services; and,

WHEREAS, funding for this contract is available from the Drainage Utility Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The findings and recitations set out in the preamble are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2.

A professional services contract with Teague Nall and Perkins, Inc. in an amount not to exceed Sixty Thousand Three Hundred and Sixty and no/100 dollars (\$60,360.00) for the design of drainage improvements in the Chapel Hill Dr., area, in substantially the same form as the attached Exhibit "A", is hereby approved.

SECTION 3.

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is

passed is open to the public as required by law and the public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.
