A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR GREEN RIBBON FUNDING FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF MEDIAN IMPROVEMENTS OF THE STATE HIGHWAY FM 1187 CORRIDOR; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (GF - TRANSPORTATION STREET BONDS)

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield (City) is a home rule municipality operating under and governed by the laws and Constitution of the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) implemented the Green Ribbon Program to allocate funds for districts with non-attainment counties to plant and establish trees and plants on the state highway system that help mitigate the effects of air pollution; and,

WHEREAS, TxDOT is accepting grant applications from agencies for the FY2025 Green Ribbon Program cycle up to \$400,000; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that constructing the median enhancements to the FM 1187 will provide a beautiful and welcoming entry point into Mansfield; and,

WHEREAS, funding for this project is available in the General Fund's Transportation Street Bond Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The findings and recitations set out in the preamble are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2.

The City Council of the City of Mansfield supports the grant application to the Texas Department of Transportation for median enhancements to FM 1187 between the western city limits and Main Street/US Hwy 287.

SECTION 3.

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is passed is open to the public by law and the public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.
