

ORDINANCE NO. 867

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE OFFICE OF  
CITY MARSHAL FOR THE JAIL DIVISION OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT  
CENTER OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD.

WHEREAS, the creation of the City Marshal's office would eliminate the need to take police department personnel away from their duties to transport persons in custody, and,

WHEREAS, the jail administration would be better able to manage prisoner flow into and out of the Law Enforcement Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The office of City Marshal for the jail division of the Law Enforcement Center of the City of Mansfield, Texas is hereby created. The City Marshal and his deputies shall be appointed by the City Manager. Their compensation shall be established by ordinance.

SECTION 2.

The City Marshal and his or her deputies, acting under the direction of the jail administrator, shall perform the following duties:

A. The City Marshal's office shall transport persons already in custody to and from the Mansfield Law Enforcement Center.

B. The City Marshal's office shall transport persons already in custody from a point of origin to a point of destination for other recognized law enforcement or detention agencies as provided for per agreement between the City and any such other agency.

C. The City Marshal's office shall transport and remain with persons requiring hospital treatment who have been officially entered into the jail book of the Mansfield Law Enforcement Center.

D. In the event of a natural disaster, personnel of the City Marshal's office may be incorporated into the emergency services of the City.

SECTION 3.

The City Marshal and his or her deputies shall meet all qualifications necessary to be certified as peace officers by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Education.

SECTION 4.

The City Marshal and his or her deputies are not members of the Police Department of the City; however, they are paid law enforcement officers for the purpose of qualifying for survivor's assistance benefits under the provisions of Article 6228F, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, as amended.


SECTION 5.

This ordinance shall be published in the Mansfield News Mirror in the City of Mansfield, Texas and shall take effect ten (10) days after the date of such publication.


