**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS,
AUTHORIZING THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF SEETON ROAD AT THE UNION
PACIFIC RAILROAD CROSSING.**

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Mansfield to provide safety on its roadways; and

WHEREAS, the railroad crossing at Seeton Road has been determined to be unsafe due to the angle at which it crosses and has been recommended for closure by Union Pacific Railroad Company and the Texas Department of Transportation and is unnecessary to stay in accordance with the City of Mansfield's Thoroughfare Plan; and

WHEREAS, Seeton Road will be constructed to the west to intersect with South Holland Road and the said majority of the construction dollars will be reimbursed by Union Pacific Railroad and the Texas Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, upon full review and consideration of all matters attendant and related thereto, the City Council agrees with the permanent closure of Seeton Road at the Union Pacific Railroad crossing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS:**

SECTION 1.

That the City Council hereby approves the permanent closure of Seeton Road at the Union Pacific Railroad crossing.
