A Resolution of the City of Mansfield authorizing the City Manager and the Police Department to accept \$3,000 of supplemental grant funding from the Texas School Safety Center at Texas State University – San Marcos for the Tobacco Enforcement Grant Project for Fiscal Year 2014 (no city match required).
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the City of Mansfield has previously been awarded a grant for the prevention of the sale of tobacco products to minors for fiscal year 2014; and
<b>WHEREAS,</b> supplemental grant funding has been identified by the Texas School Safety Center at Texas State University – San Marcos which will enhance the current project with the Mansfield Police Department by increasing the coverage of tobacco retail outlets by 204%; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the City of Mansfield has been allocated additional funding for this project in the amount of \$3,000; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the City of Mansfield Police Department, a Municipal Department, is eligible to receive and expend grant funding for Tobacco Enforcement Programs.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:
SECTION 1.
The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents and receive and expend supplemental grant funding of \$3,000 from the Texas School Safety Center at Texas State University-San Marcos for the Tobacco Enforcement Programs for State Fiscal Year 2014.
