A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF EVERMAN, TX, CITY OF FOREST HILL, TX AND THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TX FOR AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITIES FOR THE USE OF JAIL FACILITIES IN EVERMAN, TX; EVERMAN POLICE DEPARTMENT

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Mansfield desires build a new headquarters for the Mansfield Police Department requiring the demolition of the Mansfield Jail; and,

**WHEREAS**, an interlocal agreement between the City of Everman, Tx, City of Forest Hill, Tx for the use of jail facilities at the Everman City Jail while the city of Mansfield constructs a new jail in the new Mansfield Police Department; and,

**WHEREAS,** Mansfield City Jail staff will man the Everman Jail, to now include the City of Forest Hill Police to also utilize the Everman Jail for its detainees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

## **SECTION 1.**

The City Council hereby approves the interlocal agreement between the City of Everman, Tx, City of Forest Hill, Tx and the City of Mansfield, Tx.

## **SECTION 2.**

The City Council hereby delegates its authority under Texas Government Code Chapter 2269 to the City Manager, designates the City Manager as its designated representative for purposes related to this Project, and authorizes the City Manager and his designee(s) to take all actions necessary to accomplish the purposes and actions authorized herein.

## **SECTION 3.**

No delegation of authority under Section 2 of this resolution will limit the City Council's ultimate authority to select an offeror and approve a contract pursuant to Section 2269.155 of the Texas Government Code.

## **SECTION 4.**

This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the Charter of the City of Mansfield, and it is accordingly so resolved.
