A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT AND PROVIDE LOCAL FUNDING IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$20,000 FOR THE NOMINATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL RETIMING ON THE E. BROAD STREET AND FM 157 CORRIDORS FOR COMPETITION IN THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (NCTCOG) REGIONAL SIGNAL RETIMING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) issued a call for nominations in December of 2013 for communities to apply for Regional Traffic Signal Retiming with funding assistance made available through the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ);

WHEREAS, retiming of the E. Broad Street and FM 157 Corridors will provided for reduced vehicle delays, a reduction in travel time and a reduction in vehicle emissions,

WHEREAS, the signal retiming project is estimated to cost \$100,000 and the program requires a local match of 20% which the City will be responsible for an estimated \$20,000. Funds will be secured through the Traffic Operations Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS:

SECTION 1

That the City of Mansfield supports funding this project and commits to the project's development, implementation, and financing. The City is willing and able to enter into an agreement with NCTOCG by resolution or ordinance;

SECTION 2

That the City Council of the City of Mansfield adopts this resolution approving the submission of the project nomination, and the support and funding of the project should it be selected;

SECTION 3

That the City Manager is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City in all matters relating to this funding nomination and to execute all necessary applications, assurances, certifications, and other documents, relative to the submission, later acceptance, and administration of such funds.
