RESOULTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS ASHOOL SAFETY CENTER AT TEXAS STATE UNIVERSITY-SAN MARCOS, TO RECEIVE AND EXPENND GRANT FUNDING OF APPROXIMATELY \$3,900 FOR A TOBACCO ENFORCEMENT GRANT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 (NO CITY MATCH REQUIRED).

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield recognizes the inherent health issues involved with underage tobacco usage; and

WHEREAS, enforcement initiatives are necessary to prevent the sale or distribution of cigarettes and tobacco products to persons who are younger than 18 years of age; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield currently has 46 licensed tobacco retails sales locations within the city; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield Police Department, a Municipal Department, is eligible to apply for, receive and expend grant funding for Tobacco Enforcement Programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents and make application with the Texas School Safety Center at Texas State University-San Marcos, for available grant funding for Tobacco Enforcement Programs for State Fiscal Year 2014.
