A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS ASHOOOL SAFETY CENTER AT TEXAS STATE UNIVERSITY-SAN MARCOS, TO RECEIVE AND EXPENND GRANT FUNDING OF APPROXIMATELY \$3,900 FOR A TOBACCO ENFORCEMENT GRANT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 (NO CITY MATCH REQUIRED).

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield recognizes the inherent health issues involved with underage tobacco usage; and

**WHEREAS**, enforcement initiatives are necessary to prevent the sale or distribution of cigarettes and tobacco products to persons who are younger than 18 years of age; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield currently has 46 licensed tobacco retails sales locations within the city; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield Police Department, a Municipal Department, is eligible to apply for, receive and expend grant funding for Tobacco Enforcement Programs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.**

The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents and make application with the Texas School Safety Center at Texas State University-San Marcos, for available grant funding for Tobacco Enforcement Programs for State Fiscal Year 2014.
