A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF GRANULAR ACTIVATED CARBON AND SILICA SAND TO CALGON CARBON CORPORATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$934,400.00 FOR THE CONVENTIONAL FILTRATION SYSTEM AT THE BUD ERVIN WATER TREATMENT PLANT; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE (UTILITY FUND)

**WHEREAS,** The City of Mansfield (City) is a home rule municipality operating under and governed by the laws and Constitution of the State of Texas; and,

**WHEREAS**, The City has publicly advertised for and requested competitive bids for the purchase of Granular Activated Carbon and Silica Sand to be used for drinking water treatment; and,

**WHEREAS**, after review of the bids City staff recommends approving the purchase of Granular Activated Carbon and Silica Sand to Calgon Carbon Corporation; and,

WHEREAS, funding for this purchase is available from the utility fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

## **SECTION 1.**

The findings and recitations set out in the preamble are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

## **SECTION 2.**

A purchase of Granular Activated Carbon and Silica Sand with Calgon Carbon Corporation in an amount of Eight Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Five and no/100 dollars (\$889,905.00) for the Conventional Filtration System at the Bud Ervin Water Treatment Plant, is hereby approved.

## **SECTION 3.**

Funding is hereby authorized to include a five percent contingency for a total amount not to exceed Nine Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand Four Hundred and no/100 dollars (\$934,400.00) to complete the installation of Granular Activated Carbon and Silica Sand.
