## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A SHORT-TERM RAW WATER SALES AGREEMENT WITH LANE/ABRAMS JOINT VENTURE.

**WHEREAS**, Lane/Abrams Joint Venture has requested raw water be supplied for the operation of a lime stabilization plant for the Hwy 360 project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield, Texas, has determined that it has the capacity to supply raw water from a specific raw water line located near the intersection of Lonestar Road and State Highway 360; and

**WHEREAS**, the supply of raw water will reduce the need for the purchase of potable water from the drinking water system; and

WHEREAS, after review and consideration of the benefits of this agreement it has been determined that a Short-Term Raw Water Sales Agreement is in the best interest of the citizens of Mansfield, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

## **SECTION 1.**

The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement to sell raw water to Lane/Abrams Joint Venture of Mansfield, Texas as defined in the "Short Term Raw Water Sales Agreement," of the City of Mansfield, Texas for a price of \$1.96 (one dollar and ninety-six cents) per 1,000 gallons for a term not to exceed thirty six months from the execution of the agreement.
