

**RESOLUTION NO.**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A  
SHORT-TERM RAW WATER SALES AGREEMENT  
WITH LANE/ABRAMS JOINT VENTURE.**

**WHEREAS**, Lane/Abrams Joint Venture has requested raw water be supplied for the operation of a lime stabilization plant for the Hwy 360 project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield, Texas, has determined that it has the capacity to supply raw water from a specific raw water line located near the intersection of Lonestar Road and State Highway 360; and

**WHEREAS**, the supply of raw water will reduce the need for the purchase of potable water from the drinking water system; and

**WHEREAS**, after review and consideration of the benefits of this agreement it has been determined that a Short-Term Raw Water Sales Agreement is in the best interest of the citizens of Mansfield, Texas.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.**

The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement to sell raw water to Lane/Abrams Joint Venture of Mansfield, Texas as defined in the "Short Term Raw Water Sales Agreement," of the City of Mansfield, Texas for a price of \$1.96 (one dollar and ninety-six cents) per 1,000 gallons for a term not to exceed thirty six months from the execution of the agreement.
