## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (NCTCOG) TO OUTLINE THE ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF EACH PARTNER WITH RESPECT TO DEVELOPMENT OF MULTI-AGENCY COMMUNICATION, DATA AND VIDEO SHARING ON A REGIONAL INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION NETWORK; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS**, The City of Mansfield (City) is a home rule municipality operating under and governed by the laws and Constitution of the State of Texas; and,

**WHEREAS**, the North Central Texas Council of Governments is responsible for the maintenance of the North Texas Intelligent Transportation System Regional Architectural, a blueprint for transportation integration and technology advancement through agreements and implementation; and,

**WHEREAS**, a region communication network is necessary for the purpose of exchanging transportation-related when required; and,

**WHEREAS**, the North Central Texas Council of Governments will facilitate development of a regional network by establishing a North Central Texas Regional Communications Network Committee comprised of the Partners that have executed this MOU; and,

**WHEREAS**, both parties desire to enter into this MOU on the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS:

## **SECTION 1.**

That the findings and recitations set out in the preamble are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

## **SECTION 2.**

That the City Manager or designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), Attachment "A" with NCTCOG to outline the role and responsibility of each partner with respect to development of a multiagency communication data and video sharing on a regional intelligent transportation network.
