A RESOLUTION AWARDING A ONE YEAR RENEWABLE CONTRACT TO THE BEST BID FOR THE SUPPLY OF POLYALUMINUM CHLORIDE (PACL), FOR THE BUD ERVIN WATER TREATMENT PLANT.

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield, Texas, has publicly advertised for and requested competitive bids for the supply of bulk tank truck loads of poly-aluminum chloride (PACL) to be used for drinking water treatment; and,

WHEREAS, the expenditure of the funds stated herein has been incorporated into the FY-2015, FY-2016 Utility Fund Operating Budget of the City of Mansfield; and,

WHEREAS, after review and consideration of all bids received, it is the recommendation of staff and determination of City Council that the "best bid" is that of ChemTrade Chemicals; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contractual documents for the supply of bulk tank truck loads of poly-aluminum chloride (PACL) from ChemTrade Chemicals for a bid price not to exceed \$410.00 (four hundred ten dollars and no cents) per wet ton delivered for the first twelve month period of the contract, thereafter the contract may be renewed for two twelve month periods at the original bid price, if mutually agreed by both parties 30-days prior to the end of the initial twelve month period.
