A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$176,755.00, FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES, SPECIFICALLY FOR CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS ENGINEERING, TESTING AND SPECIAL INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE NEW MANSFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT TO LANDTEC ENGINEERS ARLINGTON, TX

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mansfield desires build a new headquarters for the Mansfield Police Department; and,

WHEREAS, City Staff has negotiated a proposed fee increase of \$176,755.00 with Landtec Engineers, Arlington, Tx to provide professional services specifically for construction materials engineering, testing and special inspection services for the construction of the new Mansfield Police Department building; and,

WHEREAS, Landtec Engineers has extensive experience; in the listed professional services; and,

WHEREAS, as authorized by Texas Government Code Sec. 2269.053, the City Council desires to delegate its authority under Chapter 2269 to the City Manager and desires to designate the City Manager as its designated representative for purposes related to this Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The City Council hereby approves a contract with Landtec Engineers for said services of the Project and authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2.

The City Council hereby delegates its authority under Texas Government Code Chapter 2269 to the City Manager, designates the City Manager as its designated representative for purposes related to this Project, and authorizes the City Manager and his designee(s) to take all actions necessary to accomplish the purposes and actions authorized herein.

SECTION 3.

No delegation of authority under Section 2 of this resolution will limit the City Council's ultimate authority to select an offeror and approve a contract pursuant to Section 2269.155 of the Texas Government Code.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the Charter of the City of Mansfield, and it is accordingly so resolved.
