6. <u>HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER'S REPORT</u>

Mr. Wright reported on the following items:

- The Emergency Repairs ordinance was adopted by the City Council on December 11, 2023.
- Staff was unable to submit an application for an Undertold marker before the November 2023 deadline, but a citizen's group submitted four applications for Bethlehem Baptist Church, the Colored School, the Harmony Community, and the Mansfield Community Cemetery. Mr. Wright reported that the application for the cemetery was returned because the cemetery must first have a Historic Texas Cemetery designation.
- Staff consulted with the Texas Historical Commission (THC) regarding the Historic Texas Cemetery designation. THC recommended submitting applications for the Mansfield Cemetery and the Mansfield Community Cemetery simultaneously so both cemeteries could be recognized together.
- An update was provided on the property at 302 East Broad Street.

Commissioner Walker announced that the Mansfield Cemetery Association would be holding a fundraiser on January 9, 2024.
