

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH WESTRA CONSULTANTS, LLC FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY TO EXPAND THE WILLOWSTONE ESTATES DETENTION POND IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$78,500; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (DRAINAGE UTILITY FUND)

WHEREAS, The City of Mansfield (City) is a home rule municipality operating under and governed by the laws and Constitution of the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, reports of flooding from the June 2022 rain event were received from several homes in the Spirit Walk Drive and Moore Road areas; and,

WHEREAS, in December 2022, the City engaged Westra Consultants, LLC to analyze the existing system in the area for causes of flooding; and,

WHEREAS, City staff and the consultant have concurred to further evaluate a selected alternative to resolve the flooding issues in the area; and,

WHEREAS, City staff has reviewed and considered a proposal from Westra Consultants, LLC for engineering to evaluate the feasibility of expanding the Willowstone Estates detention pond, and recommends approval of a professional services contract for said services; and,

WHEREAS, funding for this contract is available from the Drainage Utility Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The findings and recitations set out in the preamble are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2.

A professional services contract with Westra Consultants, LLC in an amount not to exceed Seventy-Eight Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 dollars (\$78,500.00) for the design of drainage improvements in the Chapel Hill Dr., area, in substantially the same form as the attached Exhibit "A", is hereby approved.

SECTION 3.

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is

passed is open to the public as required by law and the public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.
