A motion was made by Council Member Hoffman to approve the second reading of "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, AS HERETOFORE AMENDED, SO AS TO CHANGE THE ZONING ON THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTIES TO A PD. PLANNED DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT FOR RETAIL & COMMERCIAL USES, PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT: PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: PROVIDING A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE,' directing staff to move forward with project number 16-05 and a devloper agreement totaling \$1.964 million for public infrastructure related to the project with the requirement that the construction be complete by the end of 2019 and the fence line along Mitchell Road start at a point past Joe's Family Restaurant and continue south down Mitchell Road; fence to be reflective of the same quality, character, and design that is currenlty up around Best Maid Pickle location; with consideration of an addition amount of up to \$400,000 pending staff approval for offsite drainage.
