

LEGAL DESCRIPTION
PERMANENT RIGHT-OF-WAY

BEING 0.112 acre of land located in the T. J. HANKS SURVEY, Abstract No. 644, Mansfield, Tarrant County, Texas and being a portion of the Tract of land conveyed to John Ray Kelly and wife Gloria Jean Kelly by the deed recorded in Volume 7471, Page 999 of the Deed Records of Tarrant County, Texas. Said 0.112 acre being more particularly described by metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING at a 3/8" iron rod found, at the West corner of said Kelly Tract, being the intersection of the existing Southeast right-of-way line of Newt Patterson Road, with the Northeast right-of-way line of North Street;

THENCE N 60° 16' 33" E 459.77 feet, along the Northwest boundary line of said Kelly Tract, and the existing Southeast right-of-way line of said Newt Patterson Road, to a 3/8" iron rod found, at the North corner of said Kelly Tract;

THENCE S 31° 09' 12" E 10.56 feet, along the Northeast boundary line of said Kelly Tract, to a 1/2" iron rod set, in the new Southeast right-of-way line of aforesaid Newt Patterson Road;

THENCE along the new Southeast right-of-way line of said Newt Patterson Road, as follows:

1. S 60° 21' 52" W 2.07 feet, to a 1/2" iron rod set;

2. S 60° 16' 33" W 459.12 feet, to a 1/2" iron rod set, in the Southwest boundary line of said Kelly Tract, being the Northeast right-of-way line of aforesaid North Street;

THENCE N 23° 26' 54" W 10.62 feet, along the Northeast right-of-way line of said North Street, to THE PLACE OF BEGINNING, containing 0.112 acre (4,861 square feet) of land.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

BEING a tract of land located in the F. B. WADDELL SURVEY, ABSTRACT No. 1658, City of Mansfield, Tarrant County, Texas and being the remainder of that certain tract of land described in deed to Emma Sue Womack Revocable Trust recorded in Instrument No. D212124444, Tarrant County, Texas and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a 1/2-inch iron rod set with orange plastic cap stamped "R COOMBS RPLS 5294" in the Southerly right-of-way line of New Patterson Road as described in deed to the City of Mansfield recorded in Instrument No. D204224614, Tarrant County, Texas lying in the Westerly boundary line of said Womack Tract and the Easterly boundary line of Lot A, J. R. Kelly Addition to the City of Mansfield, Texas according to the plat recorded in Volume 388-166, Page 84 of the Plat Records of Tarrant County, Texas;

THENCE N 60° 18' 32" E, 700.00 feet along the said Southerly right-of-way line of New Patterson Road to an "X" cut in concrete set at its intersection with the Westerly right-of-way line of U. S. Business Highway 287 (Lt. Main Street, a variable width right-of-way);

THENCE along the Westerly right-of-way line of said Highway as follows:

S 77° 06' 50" E, 4.53 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set with orange plastic cap stamped "R COOMBS RPLS 5294" lying on a Curve to the Right;

SOUTHEASTERLY, at 278.11 feet passing a Texas Department of Transportation monument found and continuing in all a total distance of 368.03 feet along said Curve to the Right, having a radius of 2231.83 feet, a central angle of 09° 28' 56" and a chord bearing S 29° 41' 00" E, 357.63 feet to a Texas Department of Transportation monument found at the End of said Curve and the Beginning of another Curve to the Right;

SOUTHEASTERLY, 293.98 feet along said Curve to the Right, having a radius of 1859.88 feet, a central angle of 09° 02' 23" and a chord bearing S 18° 42' 21" E, 293.67 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set with orange plastic cap stamped "R COOMBS RPLS 5294" at the End of said Curve;

S 14° 08' 35" E, 123.90 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set with orange plastic cap stamped "R COOMBS RPLS 5294";

S 08° 44' 04" E, 147.60 feet to a Texas Department of Transportation monument found;

S 14° 12' 23" E, 580.49 feet to a Texas Department of Transportation monument found;

S 22° 10' 34" E, 100.97 feet to a Texas Department of Transportation monument found;

S 14° 12' 23" E, 94.43 feet to a point in the approximate centerline of Walnut Creek;

THENCE along the said approximate centerline of Walnut Creek as follows:

S 39° 31' 37" W, 117.56 feet to a point in creek;

S 65° 49' 51" W, 97.63 feet to a point in creek;

S 18° 40' 57" W, 170.00 feet to a point in creek at the most Easterly corner of that certain tract of land described in deed to Jeffrey Malone and wife, Karen Malone recorded in Volume 12315, page 1611 of the Deed Records of Tarrant County, Texas;

THENCE N 31° 01' 47" W, AT 88.0 feet passing a wood fence post found and continuing in all a total distance of 578.00 feet along the Easterly boundary line of said Malone Tract to a 1/2-inch iron rod found at the most Northerly corner thereof being the most Easterly corner of that certain tract of land described in deed to Brenda Suarez recorded in Volume 14035, Page 30 of the Deed Records of Tarrant County, Texas;

THENCE N 30° 22' 37" W, 250.36 feet along the Easterly boundary line of said Suarez Tract to a 1/2-inch iron rod found at the most Northerly corner thereof being the most Easterly corner of that certain tract of land described in deed to Randy L. Gillis and Mary S. Gillis recorded in Volume 12146, Page 1441 of the Deed Records of Tarrant County, Texas;

THENCE N 30° 47' 11" W, 384.44 feet along the Easterly boundary line of said Gillis Tract to a 1/2-inch iron rod found at the most Northerly corner thereof;

THENCE N 37° 24' 04" W, 1.31 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod found at the most Easterly corner of that certain tract of land described in deed to Guillermo Zuniga and wife, Maria Zuniga recorded in Volume 18970, Page 265 of the Deed Records of Tarrant County, Texas;

THENCE N 31° 24' 09" W, 152.00 feet along the Easterly boundary line of said Zuniga Tract to a 1/2-inch iron rod found at the most Northerly corner thereof being the most Easterly corner of aforementioned Lot A, J. R. Kelly Addition;

THENCE N 31° 28' 08" W, 444.04 feet along the Easterly boundary line of said Lot A to the PLACE OF BEGINNING, containing 21.485 acres of land.
