The Commission discussed methods to create an outreach program to provide information to property owners regarding the landmark program. The Commission also discussed the possibility of requesting a joint work session with the City Council to exchange views on the preservation program in Historic Downtown Mansfield.

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HLC#24-009: Discussion and Possible Action Regarding the Regulations Allowing the Suspension of Demolition Permits for Historic Properties

Mr. Wright gave a presentation on the regulations in Section 155.069 of the Code of Ordinances, "Historic Overlay District Regulations", related to the Commission's ability to suspend demolition permit applications for historic properties for a limited period. Mr. Wright explained the difference in the regulations regarding properties designated as historic landmarks and properties eligible to be historic landmarks.

The Commission discussed the types of historic properties to which these regulations might apply and noted that a suspension must be done with care. Mr. Wright explained that the Commission must have a plan of action ready if a suspension is issued. The Commission determined that properties designated as Officially Recognized historic resources should be considered for preservation if a demolition permit application was received by the City.

The Commission discussed how properties threatened with demolition could be brought to the Commission for review.

After discussion, Commissioner Walker made a motion to direct the Historic Preservation Officer to notify the Commission when a demolition permit application is received for a Officially Recognized historic resource and to schedule a meeting of the Commission to determine if a suspension of the permit application is warranted.
