A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR SHARED DIGITAL LIBRARY SERVICES WITH THE CITIES OF ARLINGTON, KENNEDALE, AND GRAND PRAIRIE.

WHEREAS, In 2010, the Arlington Public Library and Mansfield Public Library entered into an interlocal agreement that provided access to public library collections and services by the citizens of both cities in each city's library; and

WHEREAS, the current agreement has been so successful between Mansfield and Arlington, that both cities would like to extend the interlocal agreement to include the cities of Kennedale and Grand Prairie; and

WHEREAS, expanding the interlocal agreement to include Kennedale and Grand Prairie will provide the citizens of all four cities with access to the public library collections and digital services from all four libraries, in effect, providing one large multi-access public library system.

WHEREAS, there are no additional costs to the City other than those already approved in the FY2013/2014 budget.
