**A RESOLUTION TO CONSIDER AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO MORALES CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$65,850 FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE MANSFIELD MEMORIAL PLAZA**

**WHEREAS**, for several years, the City Council has operated with a sub-committee appointed to study public memorials within the City, reviewing topics such as memorial benches and trees, veterans' memorials, locations of public memorials, and criteria for inclusion on public memorials; and

**WHEREAS**, during the course of their discussions, the sub-committee identified the need for a memorial plaza to honor first responders who have fallen in the line of duty; and

**WHEREAS**, staff from the Police, Fire, City Attorney and Parks and Recreation Departments met to discuss design elements and proposed criteria for inclusion on the memorial; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for the construction of a memorial plaza has been allocated in the FY2016-2017 budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS:**

**Section 1.**

That the City Council approves awarding a construction contract to Morales Construction Services, Inc. for construction of the Mansfield Memorial Plaza in the amount of Sixty-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$65,850).
