

ORDINANCE NO. 1009

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING CHAPTER 4, BILLBOARDS AND SIGNS, SECTION 4.109
POLITICAL SIGNS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PERMIT
POLITICAL SIGNS ON DESIGNATED AREAS OF THE CITY HALL AND
ADJACENT COMMON AREAS DURING ELECTION PERIODS.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE HILLS, TEXAS that Chapter 4, Billboards and Signs, Section 4.109, Political Signs is amended by adopting the following provisions to be added to the end of Subsection (a) of Section 4.109:

“,provided however, political signs not exceeding four (4) square feet in area may be placed at city hall and the adjacent common areas in locations delineated therefor by the City Manager when the city hall is being used as a polling place for a city, county, state or federal election, with such signs to be installed no more than forty-eight (48) hours before the commencement of early voting for the applicable election and to be removed within twenty-four (24) hours after the close of voting for the applicable election. Removal and care of the signs is the sole responsibility of the candidate or the person who installed the sign, including the local campaign manager of the candidate. Any political signs installed prior to the authorized time, placed in a location other than the location delineated by the City Manager, or not removed within twenty-four (24) hours of the close of an election, may be removed by city personnel and destroyed.”
