A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$586,084.53 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT (AFA) FOR VOLUNTARY LOCAL GOVERNMENT CONTRIBUTIONS FOR ADDITIONAL AESTHETICS AND ROADWAY SCOPE FOR THE US 287 FRONTAGE ROADS (UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD TO LONE STAR ROAD) PROJECT; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE (STREET BOND FUND)

WHEREAS, The City of Mansfield (City) is a home rule municipality operating under and governed by the laws and Constitution of the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, Government Code, Chapter 791, and Transportation Code, 201.209 and Chapter 221, authorize the State to contract with municipalities and political subdivisions; and,

WHEREAS, it is recognized that it is the best interest of the citizens of the City of Mansfield that the City of Mansfield enter into a Local Project Advance Funding Agreement for Voluntary Local Government Contributions with the Texas Department of Transportation; and,

WHEREAS, Texas Department of Transportation and the City of Mansfield have agreed to said terms of the Advance Funding Agreement for Voluntary Local Government Contributions; and,

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation and the City of Mansfield have agreed to contract with each other for the funding and construction of said improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That the findings and recitations set out in the preamble are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2.

That the City Manager or designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute Advance Funding Agreement for Voluntary Local Government Contributions with the Texas Department of Transportation for additional aesthetics and roadway scope for the US 287 Frontage Roads (Union Pacific Railroad to Lone Star Road) Project.

SECTION 3.

That funding is hereby authorized in the amount of Five Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Eighty-Six and 53/100 Dollars (\$586,084.53) to construct the improvements.

SECTION 4.

That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is passed is open to the public as required by law and the public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required.

SECTION 5.

That this Resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.
