A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, AWARDING AN ANNUAL CONTRACT TO YELLOW LANDSCAPE IN THE AMOUNT \$75,331.15 FOR GROUNDS MAINTENANCE OF PARKS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS RESOLUTION; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (GENERAL FUND, MPFDC ½ CENT SALES TAX)

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield (the "City") is a municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Texas authorized to finance its activities by issuing obligations; and,

WHEREAS, the City continues to add new parks and municipal facilities to enhance the aesthetics and services of the community; and,

WHEREAS, these improved areas must be maintained and hiring this service out will allow staff to concentrate on high end maintenance areas; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield has publicly advertised and requested competitive bids for contract mowing in February 2024; and,

WHEREAS, all constitutional and statutory prerequisites for the approval of this resolution have been met, including but not limited to the Open Meetings Act; and,

WHEREAS, after review of the bids received, City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Mansfield to award a contract to Yellowstone Landscape for contractual grounds maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The findings and recitations set out in the preamble are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2.

An annual contract with Yellowstone Landscape for grounds maintenance of City properties and sites in the amount of \$75,331.15 hereto is hereby approved.
