**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, APPROVING THE CANVASS OF THE MAY 12, 2012 GENERAL AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, a general election was duly held in the City of Mansfield, Texas, on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2012 to elect a Council Member, Place 3, Council Member, Place 4; and Council Member, Place 5; and

**WHEREAS**, a special election was duly held in the City of Mansfield, Texas, on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2012 to submit the following proposition to the qualified voters of the City of Mansfield:

**SECTION 1.**

**RESULTS OF THE CANVASS FOR THE CITY COUNCIL**

**COUNCIL MEMBER, PLACE 3:**

Stephen Lindsey is hereby declared to be elected to the office of Council Member, Place 3.

**COUNCIL MEMBER, PLACE 4:**

Darryl W. Haynes is hereby declared to be elected to the office of Council Member, Place 4.

**COUNCIL MEMBER, PLACE 5:**

Since no candidate received a majority of the votes as required by the Mansfield Charter, there will be a runoff election held on June 23, 2012 between Cory Hoffman (Incumbent) and Gary Mills.

**SECTION 2.  
RESULTS OF THE CANVASS FOR THE PROPOSITION**

The proposition failed by a margin of 1,476 votes.

**SECTION 3.**

The City Council finds that the results of the general and special elections as set forth above are correct and the canvass of votes is hereby approved.

**SECTION 4.**

As a result of this canvass, the City Council hereby finds and determines that a total of 2,548 persons voted in the election.

**SECTION 5.  
EFFECTIVE DATE**

This resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.
