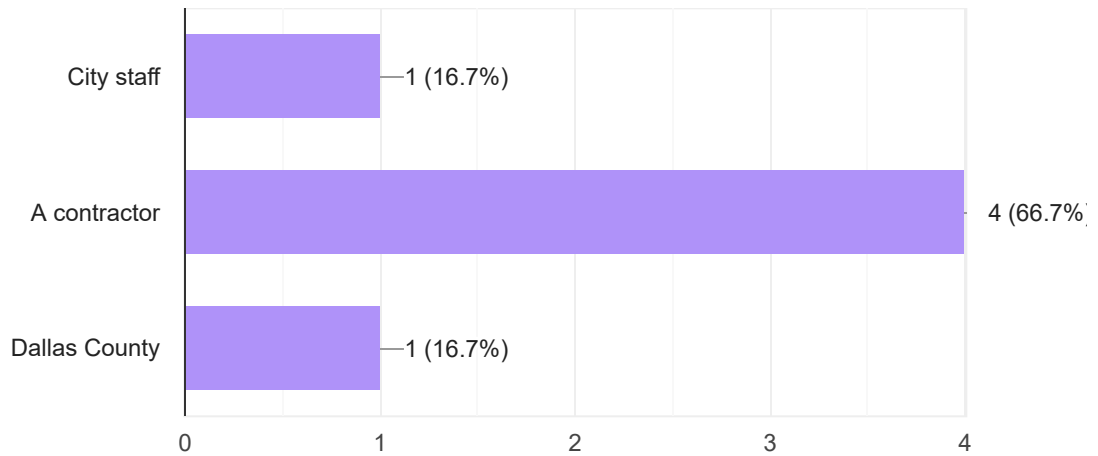

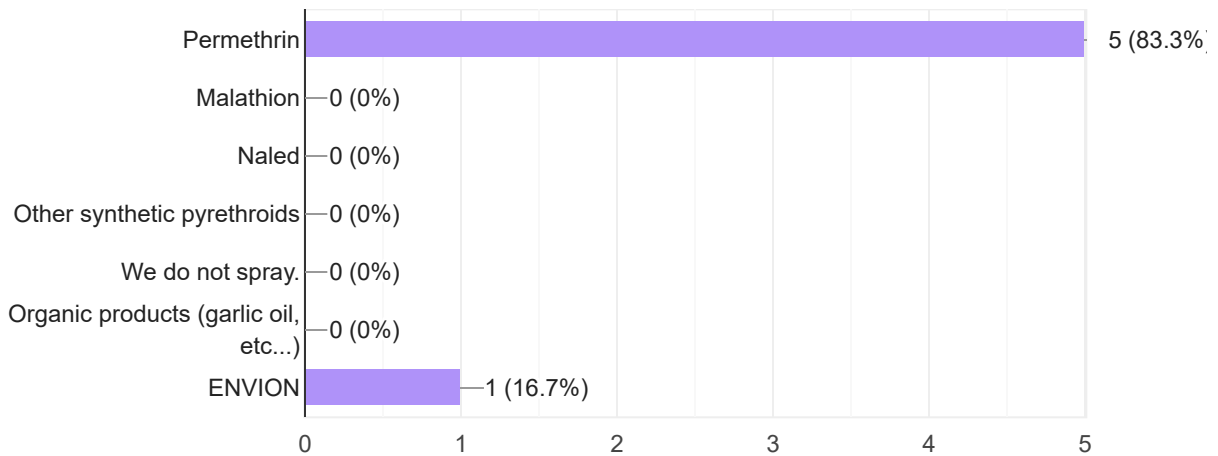

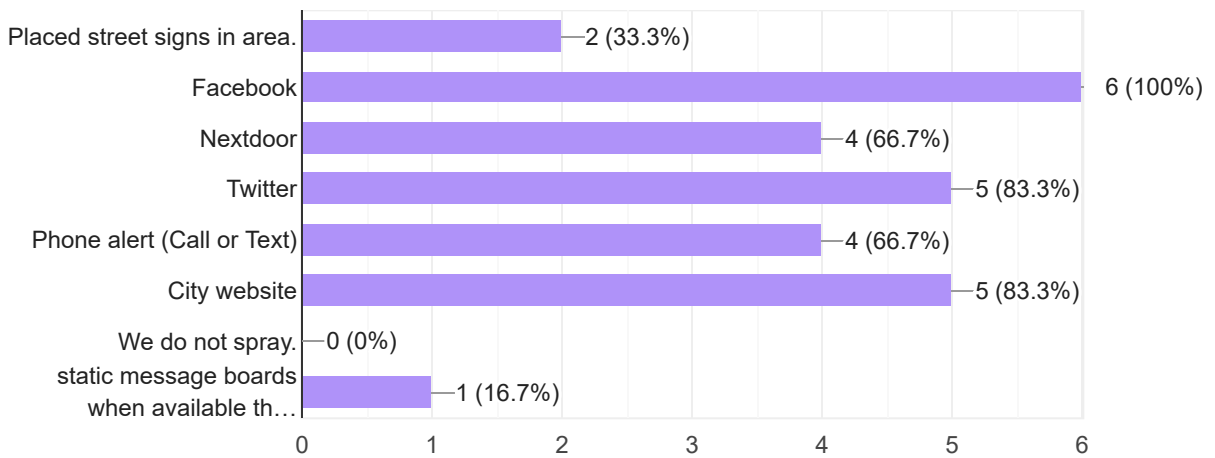

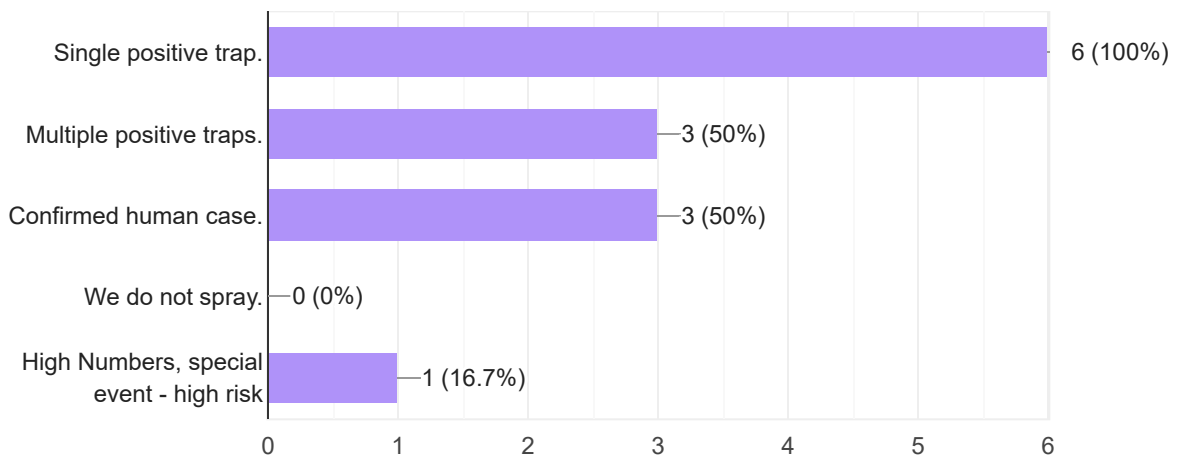

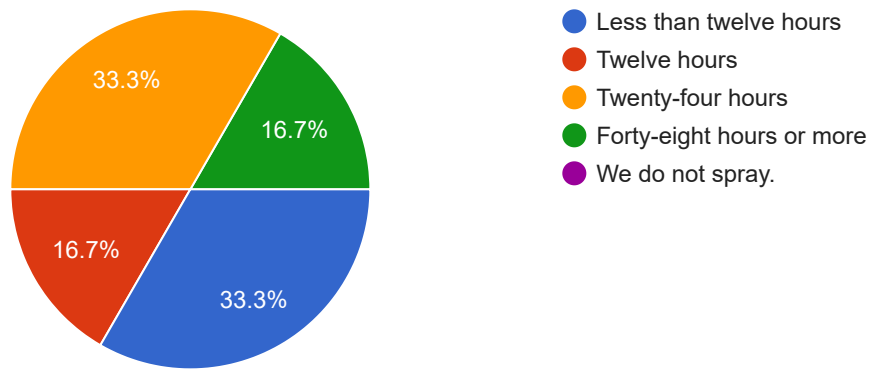

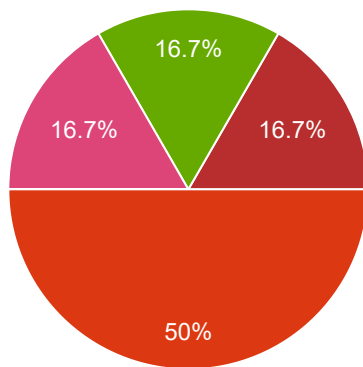

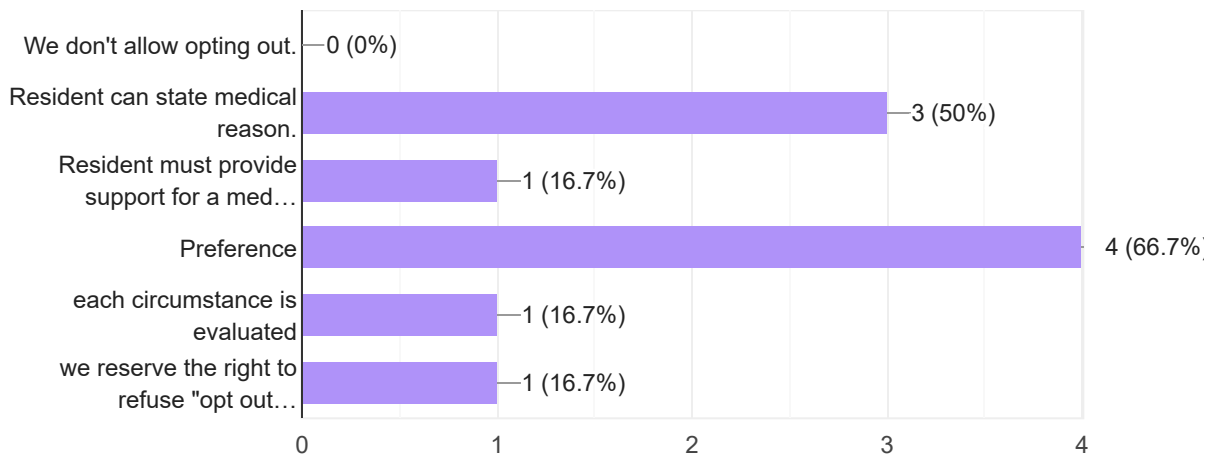

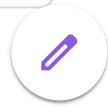
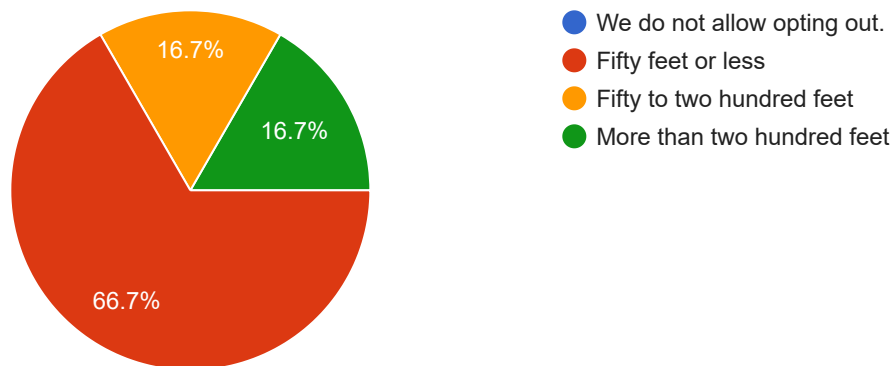
If 'yes' or 'sometimes,' on what grounds can someone "opt-out?" (Choose all that apply)

only stop spraying route in front of resident request to opt out

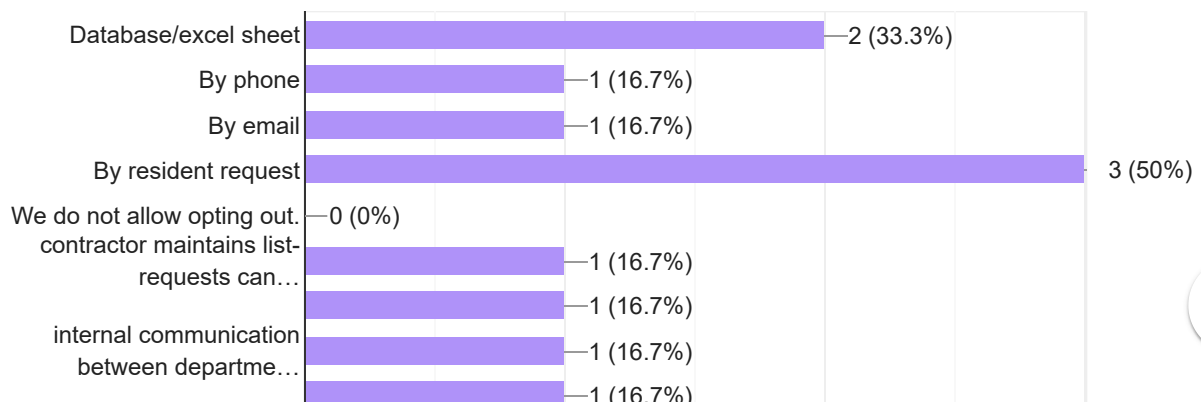
sprayer is shut off at the property line of the opt out person and back on at the property line of the opt in person

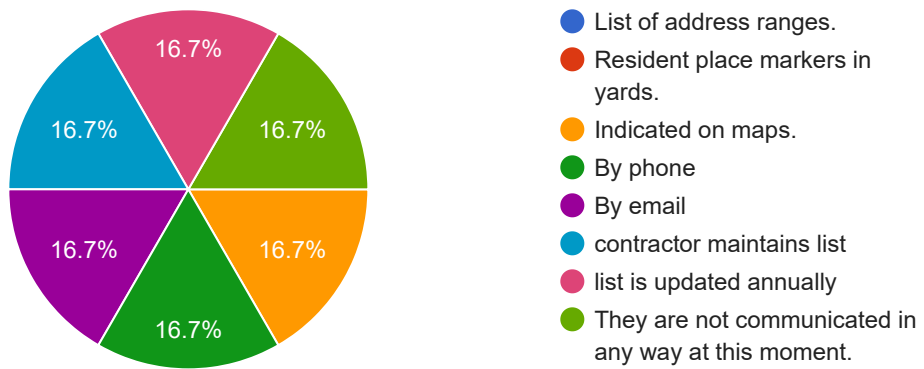

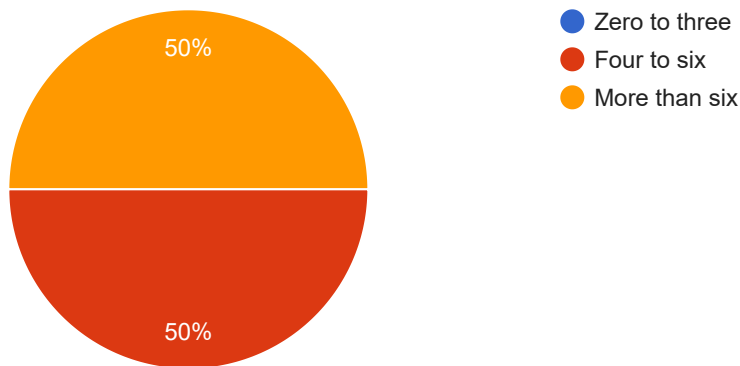
How are opt out addresses communicated to the people conducting spraying?

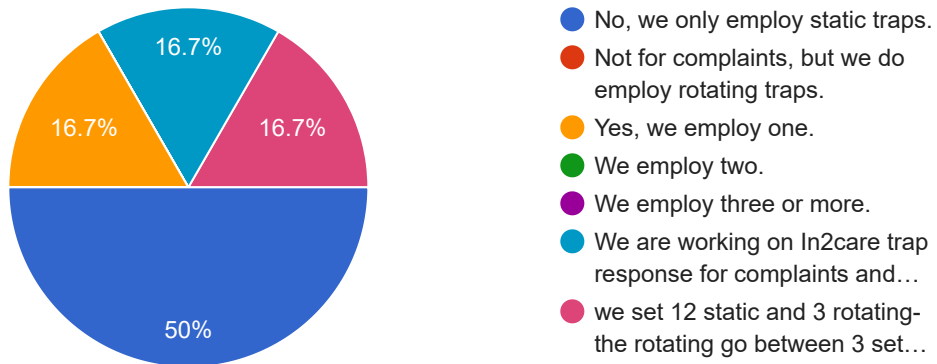
How many static traps does your city employ?

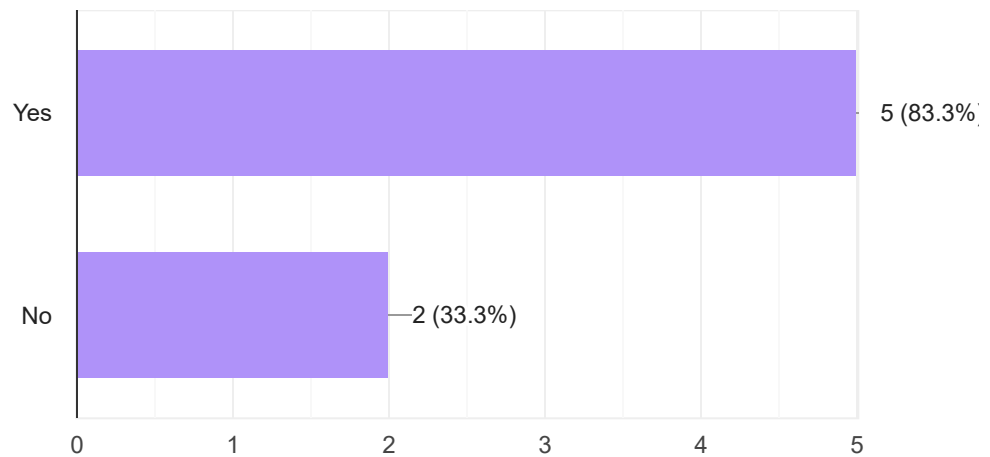
