

## **RESOLUTION NO.**

### **A RESOLUTION AWARDING BIDS FOR FOOD FOR THE MANSFIELD LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield, has publicly advertised for the requested competitive bids for food for the Mansfield Law Enforcement Center; and

**WHEREAS**, all bids were received, opened, and publicly read on march 13, 2012 at 3:00 pm at Mansfield City Hall; and

**WHEREAS**, the expenditure for food was budgeted for and will be taken from the General Operating Funds of the Mansfield Law Enforcement Center; and

**WHEREAS**, after review and consideration of all bids received, it is the best recommendation of the administration and determination of Council that the "lowest and best bids" are: Ben E. Keith in the amount of \$ 142,450.50, and Brynes Brothers in the amount of \$ 46,072.59.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS:**

#### **SECTION 1.**

The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to enter into agreement with Ben E. Keith in the amount currently projected at One hundred forty - two thousand, four hundred fifty, and fifty cents (\$ 142,450.50). Byrne Brothers in the amount currently projected at Forty - six thousand, seventy - two dollars and fifty - nine cents ( \$46,072.59).

#### **SECTION 2.**

If at any time a vendor is unable to honor the bid price, written notification is required. The item will be reviewed and the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to award item to the next lowest bidder if necessary.

#### **SECTION 3.**

The City Manager is hereby authorized to approve any change order up to 25% of the contract price as authorized by the Texas Local Government Code.
