Ordinance - Public Hearing Continuation and Second and Final Reading on an Ordinance Approving a Change of Zoning from PD, Planned Development District to S, South Mansfield Form Based Development District and C-2, Community Business District on Approximately 57.95 Acres in the John Robertson Survey, Abstract No. 1317, City of Mansfield, Tarrant County, Texas, Generally Located east of U.S. Highway 287, East and West of N.
