A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE APPLICATION, RECEIVE AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS FROM THE AMERICAN SOCIETY FOR THE PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS (ASPCA) FY 2012 GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, The City of Mansfield Animal Care and Control is a shelter providing services to the citizens of the City of Mansfield (Tarrant/Johnson/Ellis Counties) and meets the criteria for grant funding currently available from the American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA) for the Fiscal Year 2012; and

WHEREAS, The City of Mansfield agrees to comply with all program rules as set out in the grant program guidelines; and

WHEREAS, The City of Mansfield designates Clayton W. Chandler (City Manager) as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents with the American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA) for Fiscal Year 2012 and request grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$16,200 with no cash match.
2. Grant funding, if awarded, will be utilized to purchase Records Management Software for the Animal Care and Control Division.
