**A RESOLUTION TO CONSIDER AN ADDENDUM ALLOWING THE CITY MANAGER AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO RECEIVE AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDING FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS FOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE PROJECTS THAT REDUCE CRIME AND IMPROVE THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM DURING THE FY2015 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$69,432 WITH NO MATCH REQUIRED.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council approved for the City of Mansfield and the Police Department to make application to the Criminal Justice Division of the Governor's Office of the State of Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield and the police department have been awarded a grant in the amount of \$69,432 with no match required; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield and the police department agree to comply with all program rules as set out in the grant program guidelines; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield and the police department agree that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City of Mansfield assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield designates Clayton W. Chandler (City Manager) as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to accept the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to authorize the City Manager and the police department to make accept and expend the above mentioned grant allocation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.**

1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents and accept state grant funds from the State of Texas in FY2015 in the amount of \$69,432.
2. The City Manager or designee is authorized to expend grant funding in the amount of \$69,432 for FY2015 grant program.
