A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, AWARDING A BID FOR A CONSTRUCTION REMODELING CONTRACT FOR THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS TO PRO RENO GROUP IN THE AMOUNT OF \$249,448.00; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE (CAPITAL FUND)

WHEREAS, The City of Mansfield (City) is a home rule municipality operating under and governed by the laws and Constitution of the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council Chamber has held public meetings for over twenty (20) years and is in need of upgrades and modernization; and,

WHEREAS, the City issued RFB 2023-45-13-01 seeking bids for the construction remodel of the City Council Chambers; and,

WHEREAS, City staff opened bids on November 9, 2023, receiving three bids, attached as Exhibit A, and after review of the bids recommend Pro Reno Group be awarded the bid for this project; and,

WHEREAS, Funding for this construction remodeling contract for the City Council Chambers is available from the Capital Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

That the findings and recitations set out in the preamble are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2.

That the bid to Pro Reno Group in the amount of Two Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Four Hundred Forty Eight dollars \$249,448.00 for the construction remodeling contract for the City Council Chambers is hereby awarded and a contract in substantially the same form as attached Exhibit B is hereby approved.

SECTION 3.

That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is passed is open to the public as required by law and the public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required.

SECTION 4.

That this Resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.
