A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT (MPD) TO MAKE APPLICATION, RECEIVE, AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FY 2017 SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (STEP GRANT) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$110,000 WITH A 20% IN-KIND MATCH (\$22,000).

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield and the MPD is a unit of local government that meets the criteria established by the Texas Department of Transportation to apply for and receive grant funds under this program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield and the MPD is eligible for an amount not to exceed \$110,000 in grant program funding with a 20% in-kind match (\$22,000); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield and the MPD agrees to comply with all program rules as set out in the grant program guidelines; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield designates Clayton W. Chandler (City Manager) as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to ratify and authorize the City Manager and the MPD to make application, receive, and expend the above mentioned grant allocation, if awarded.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

## **SECTION 1.**

- 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents and make application with the Texas Department of Transportation Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) Grant Program.
- 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized to receive and expend the grant funding, if awarded, by the STEP Grant Program.
