**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A FIVE-YEAR CONTRACT WITH THE TRINITY RIVER AUTHORITY FOR INDUSTRIAL SAMPLING AND ANALYTICAL SERVICE, FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (UTILITY FUND)**

**WHEREAS**, The City of Mansfield (City) is a home rule municipality operating under and governed by the laws and Constitution of the State of Texas; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mansfield contracts with the Trinity River Authority (TRA) to treat all wastewater effluent; and,

**WHEREAS**, the TRA owns and operates a regulatory services and compliance laboratory certified by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to analyze environmental samples under National Laboratory Accreditation Conference standards; and,

**WHEREAS**, the expenditure of the funds stated herein has been incorporated into the Water & Sewer System Operating Budget; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Mansfield, Texas, has determined that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Mansfield to enter into a technical services contract to provide necessary industrial sampling, inspections, and analytical services needed to operate and administer the City of Mansfield Pretreatment Program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.**

The findings and recitations set out in the preamble are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

**SECTION 2.**

The City Manager of his designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute contractual documents with the Trinity River Authority of Texas for technical services related to the operation and administration of the City of Mansfield Texas Industrial Pretreatment Program on a cost-per-service basis as outlined in the fee schedule attached in the contract for a term of five years.

**SECTION 3.**

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is passed is open to the public as required by law and the public notice of the time, place, and purpose

of said meeting was given as required.

**SECTION 4.**

This Resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.
