

RESOLUTION NO. _____**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE CULTURAL ARTS MASTER PLAN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield (the “City”) is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5, of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and,

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the importance of cultural arts and the positive impact they have on the community's quality of life, economic development, and overall well-being; and,

WHEREAS, the City has undertaken a comprehensive planning process to create a Cultural Arts Master Plan that provides a vision and roadmap for the development and promotion of cultural arts in the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Cultural Arts Master Plan has been crafted based upon the recommendations from the Mansfield Cultural Arts Commission and the public input from the Mansfield community; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to formally adopt the Cultural Arts Master Plan as an official guiding document for the future development of cultural arts in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That the Cultural Arts Master Plan, attached as Exhibit “A,” is hereby adopted as an official guiding document for the City.

SECTION 2.

That the Cultural Arts Master Plan shall serve as a roadmap for the development, promotion, and enhancement of cultural arts in the City. The plan is intended to guide public and private investment in cultural arts programs, facilities, and initiatives and to promote the cultural vitality of the community.

SECTION 3.

That the City Manager and relevant City departments shall take appropriate actions to implement the goals and objectives outlined in the Cultural Arts Master Plan in coordination with the Mansfield Cultural Arts Commission.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
