

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, REJECTING ALL BIDS RECEIVED FOR RIGHT OF WAY LITTER COLLECTION FOR YEAR 2024; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield (“City”) is a home rule municipality operating under and governed by the laws and Constitution of the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield published an Invitation to Bid for litter collection along public rights of way within the City; and,

WHEREAS, sealed bids were received, opened, and publicly read aloud on February 13, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, the Invitation for Bids provided that the City of Mansfield reserved the sole right to accept or reject any bid for any reason determined to be in the best interest of the citizens of Mansfield, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, five bids were received, which after thorough evaluation were determined to not be in the best interest of citizens due to unbudgeted costs it is the recommendation of staff and determination of City Council that the bids be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

All bids received in connection with Bid Proposal Number 2024-41-04-01, Right of Way Litter Collection for 2024 are hereby rejected.
