WORK SESSION

Discussion Regarding the Street Capital Improvement Program

Assistant Director of Public Works - City Engineer Raymond Coffman presented the Roadway Capital Improvement Program and spoke on regional transportation projects, project evaluation, capital improvement progress update, and a five year capital improvement program update. Developer Interviews for New Public Facilities at the Lone Star 360 Development

Ms. Stevenson spoke on Mansfield demographics, data collection and analysis, density, travel estimates, funding programs, and an estimated implementation schedule for the on-demand microtransit project. Wayne Gensler, Chief Operating Officer for Trinity Metro, gave a presentation on Mansfield Zipzone. Mr. Gensler spoke on zipzone, VIA, Mansfield transit usage/trends, the Mansfield proposal, and answered Council questions.
