Approval of Last Meeting Minutes

Chairman Smith called for approval of the minutes of the September 20, 2016, meeting. Commissioner Short made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Commissioner Rivera seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

HLC#16-003: Public hearing to consider a request for a Historic Landmark Overlay District designation for the Mansfield Chamber of Commerce Building, historically known as the Big Daylight Store Building, located at 114 N. Main Street

Mr. Wong, representing the applicant, gave a brief overview of the request, powerpoint presentation and was available for questions.

Chairman Smith opened the public hearing and called for anyone wishing to speak to come forward.

Seeing no one come forward to speak, Chairman Smith closed the public hearing.

Chairman Smith inquired about a plaque for the building at which time Mr. Wong stated that the building would qualify for a plaque, however this type of plaque is no longer available. Chairman Smith requested that this be researched and he would personally fund a plaque if a similar product can be found.

Vice-Chairman Littlefield made a motion to approve the request. Commissioner Short seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

Discussion Item: Lowering the speed limit in Historic Downtown Mansfield

Mr. Wong gave a brief presentation (with chart and information provided by Commissioner Parker) and power point of the traffic in Historic Downtown Mansfield and the need for a slower speed. He noted that a slower speed of 25-30 mph would be more bike and pedestrian friendly and would promote more business downtown.

COMMENTS AND CONSIDERATIONS

The applicant is seeking approval new signage at 131 N. Main St. The new sign will replace the existing sign from the previous tenant. The new sign will use baked enamel paint, and the text color will be green.

This building was constructed in 1915 for the Southland Ice Company. The extra thick walls and high threshold of the building are characteristic of ice houses. The area behind the building was where the wagons and teams were loaded with block ice for distribution. Former significant owners included Clyde P. Holland, who operated an insurance business out of the building, and Lon T. Hubbard, a former mayor of Mansfield.


