

**WHEREAS;** Harvesting International Ministries Inc., better known as the H.I.M. Center is a non-profit agency that works with communities to provide long-term solutions to poverty, serving approximately 100,000 people in over 25 counties throughout North Texas; and

**WHEREAS,** H.I.M Center serves over 50,000 individuals across North Texas through its Bagged Groceries program, Healthy Families program, Partner Pantry program, and Disaster Relief program, as well as the National Angel Food program and the Vitamin Relief USA program; and

**WHEREAS,** Recently, the H.I.M Center of Mansfield was recognized by the Tarrant Area Food Bank for a Food Bank Presidential Award; and

**WHEREAS,** The Harvesting In Mansfield Food Bank distributed 2.7 million pounds of food, in conjunction with the Tarrant Area Food Bank in 2021. This was the most food distributed within 13 counties and more than any of the 400 agencies the Tarrant Area Food Bank serves. The dollar value of the partnered food distribution from the H.I.M Center was \$4,800,000 dollars; and

**WHEREAS,** The H.I.M Center distributed 8.1 million pounds of total food in 2021, with a retail dollar value of \$21,600,00; and

**WHEREAS,** In 2021, 1,700 Mansfield families found their way back to hope and food security, no longer needing the services of H.I.M Center for groceries.
