In addition to the steel casing, the bore head was not able to be retrieved. The cost of the bore head and hose is \$92,000. The remaining cost correlates with the labor and equipment associated with the attempt to salvage the steel casing pipe, grouting the line, filling in the old bore pits and digging new ones. |

This contingency is for any unknown items that may arise from now until Blackrock returns to complete the adjustment of maholes after the TxDOT frontage road project is complete.  |
