A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,047,338.29 FOR PROCUREMENT OF VENDORS AND EQUIPMENT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF AN ADVANCED TRAFFIC MANANGEMENT SYSTEM (ATMS) AND SCHOOL ZONE SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need to proceed forward with the procurement of equipment and installation for an ATMS and School Zone System for the benefit of the citizens of the City of Mansfield; and,

WHEREAS, the City Staff has reviewed the quotes which were obtained though Buy Board and the Department of Information Resources (DIR) for the ATMS and School Zone System; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has received the recommendation of Staff to approve purchase orders with Presidio Networked Solutions Group, LLC, JTS and Paradigm Traffic for equipment and installation; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize and secure funds from the Street Bond Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

Funding is hereby authorized in the amount of One Million Forty Seven Thousand, Three Hundred Thirty Eight and 29/100 Dollars (\$1,047,338.29) for equipment and installation for the ATMS and School Zone System.

SECTION 2.

City Staff is hereby authorized and directed to open a purchase order with Presidio Networked Solutions Group, LLC for an amount of Eighty One Thousand, Two Hundred Seventeen and 60/100 (\$81,217.60).

SECTION 3.

City Staff is hereby authorized and directed to open a purchase order with JTS for an amount of Four Hundred Twenty Thousand, Three Hundred Sixty and 69/100 (\$420,360.69).

SECTION 4.

City Staff is hereby authorized and directed to open a purchase order with Paradigm Traffic for an amount of Two Hundred Sixty Four Thousand, Three Hundred Ten and 00/100 (\$264,310.00) for the ATMS.

SECTION 5.

City Staff is hereby authorized and directed to open a purchase order with Paradigm Traffic for an amount of Two Hundred Eleven Thousand, Four Hundred Fifty and 00/100 (\$211,450.00) for the School Zone System.
