A motion was made by Council Member Newsom to approve the second reading of "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 73, OF THE TRAFFIC CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 545.356 OF THE TEXAS TRANSPORTATION CODE CONCERNING THE **AUTHORITY TO ALTER SPEED LIMITS ON SPECIFIC STREETS AND** HIGHWAYS BEING AN ORDINANCE ALTERING THE PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED FOR VEHICLES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 545.356 OF THE TEXAS TRANSPORTATION CODE, REGULATING SPEED LIMTS ON HIGHWAYS AND ROADWAYS, UPON THE BASIS OF AN **ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC INVESTIGATION WITHIN THE CORPORATE** LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD AS SET OUT IN THE ORDINANCE: REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY."
